## **PROFILE OF MADHYA PRADESH WITH RELEVANCE TO DISASTER**

Madhya Pradesh the \_Heart of India's the second largest state of the country. Due to its diverse physiographic feature and richness in resources it is prone to multi hazard problems which includes both natural and industrial hazard and makes the 7.25 crore<sup>1</sup> population vulnerable to such calamities. As a matter of fact, Madhya Pradesh has faced major disasters, especially in last 30 years. Bhopal gas tragedy is one of the most popular industrial catastrophes caused in Indian history. First India 's urban earthquake hit the Jabalpur<sup>2</sup> , 6 to 12 times occurred floods in last 26 years, drought are some of the calamities which highlights the need of proper disaster management plan for the state. Although section 23 of the DM Act 2005 provides guidelines that there shall be a DM plan for every state but it's also the realization of the requirement of such plans emerging within the state that makes the purpose of the plan more effective. It then helps in the involvement of different stakeholders to come up with problem based requirements.

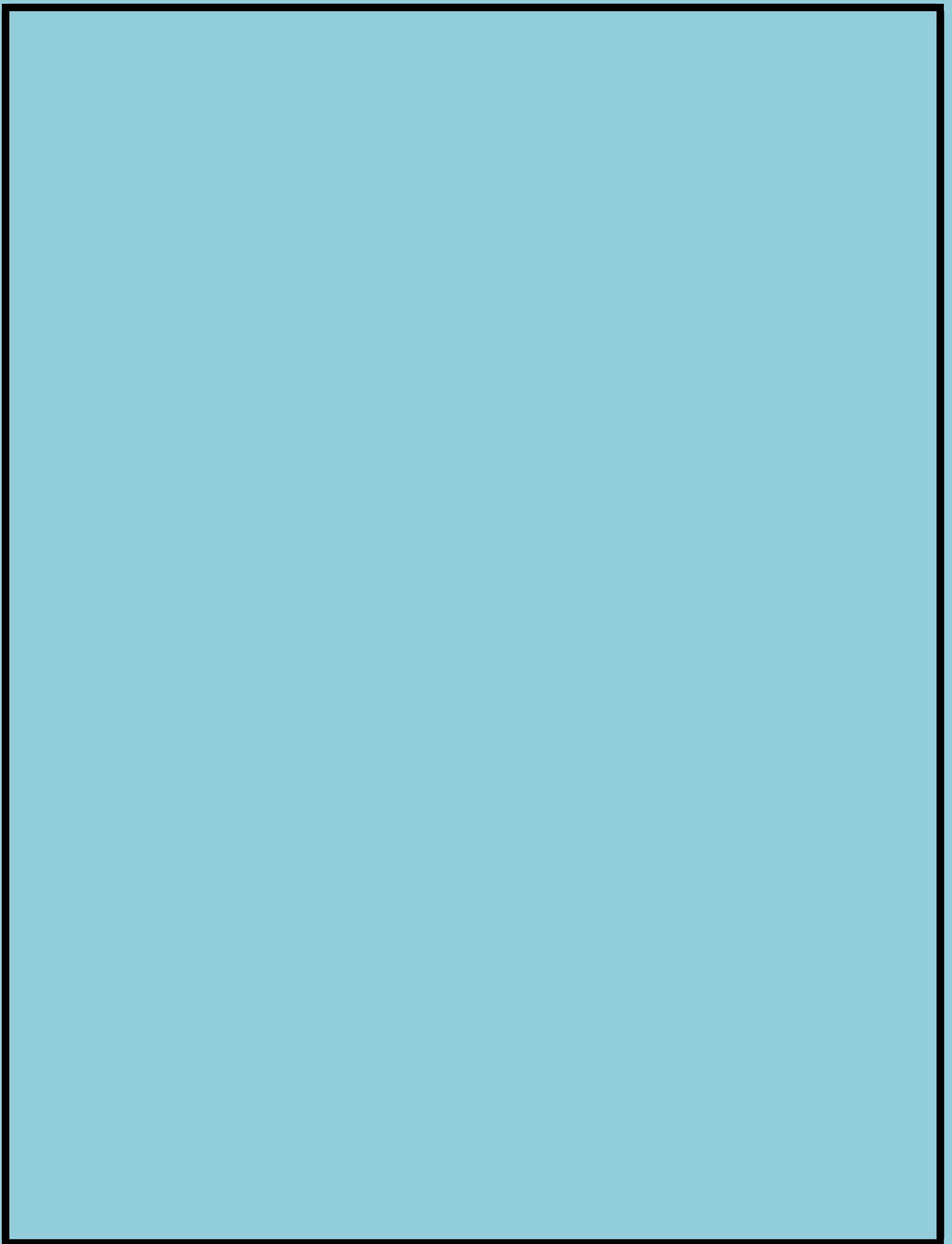
