



The National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD)

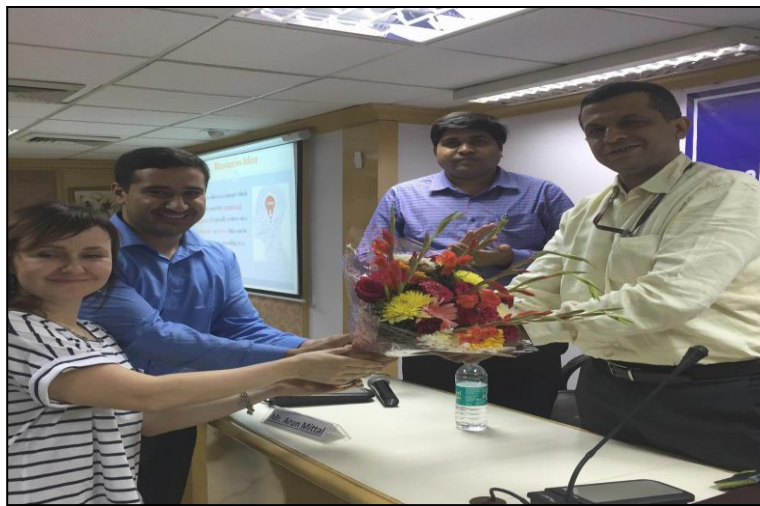
